

User licence agreement for CoreEditor packet.

ATTENTION ! Before install CoreEditor packet please read this document, because it's a law agreement, which says about licency right for CoreEditor packet. In case of no acceptance this conditions you have to stop installation, dissemination or any other usage CoreEditor packet as whole or any of its components.

DEFINITIONS

- CoreEditor packet - in abbreviation Packet - CoreEditor programm with all DLL libraries, plugins, templets, scripts and any other additions installed together.
- User - natural person or legal person who uses CoreEditor packet, one of sided in this agreement.
- Service - official CoreEditor website, available at the address of <http://www.coreeditor.pl>
- Commercial goals (commercial usage) - usage packet to earn money.

1. Copyright

If there isn't any other statement, all copyrights for all components of CoreEditor packet belong to BinSoft Karol Wierchołowski. CoreEditor packet is secured by copyrights, international agreement regarding copyright and other law regulations. Breaking these laws is liable to civil and legal liability.

2. Distribution

The sole distributor of the CoreEditor program is BinSoft Karol Wierchołowski.

3. Agreement sides

The agreement is contracted by: BinSoft Karol Wierchołowski, named as a Licensor and an User named as a license holder.

4. Contracting an agreement

The agreement is contracted by packet install.

5. Dissolution

Rights of license holder come from this agreement expire in date of dissolution, which results in breaking any agreement resolution.

6. License types

Using CoreEditor packet can go on following licence types:

- DEMO
- HOME
- EDUCATION
- PROFESSIONAL
- ENTERPRISE

6.1. DEMO License

Installation and running program without registration process results that a user uses packet at DEMO license level. Within a framework of this license, a user has the right to use this program in only 31 days from installation date, only on one PC. The user has the right to run the program max. 100 times. After the mentioned time or spend 100 runnings the program should be deinstalled, in other case there would result a breaking of this agreement.

DEMO version has some limits in CoreEditor packet functionality. Doesn't allow for its commercial use.

6.2. HOME license

User gets HOME license after registering in service, pay the license fee and get special codes to unlock it. Within a framework of this license the user gets the right to free CoreEditor packet updates during one year. This License doesn't allow for commercial usage of this packet.

6.3. EDUCATION license

EDUCATION license can be used by education institutions (schools, colleges, universities etc.). To get this type of license registration and getting unlock key is required. Within a framework of this license user gets the right to free CoreEditor packet updates on unlimited time.

6.4. PROFESSIONAL license

PROFESSIONAL license can be obtained after registration in service, pay the license fee and get unlock codes. In a framework of this type of license the user gets the right to CoreEditor packet free updates during one year. This license allows to use CoreEditor packet for commercial activities.

6.5. ENTERPRISE license

ENTERPRISE license can be obtained after registration in service, pay the license fee and get unlock codes. In a framework of this type of license the user gets the right to CoreEditor packet free

updates during one year. This license allows to use CoreEditor packet for commercial activities. In this type of license there are unlocked any options which were not available in previous types of licenses.

DEMO, HOME and PROFESSIONAL licenses allow to install and run program on only one PC. EDUCATION license allows to install and use program on any number of PCs in given education institution. ENTERPRISE license allows to install and use CoreEditor packet on four PCs.

There is a possibility to extend the PCs numbers. It is related with fees shown in pricelist available at our website.

7. Description of license holder rights

- Sharing packet only in unregistered DEMO version.
- Packet can be shared only in version provided by BinSoft Karol Wierzchołowski.
- Use scripts and templates installed together with CoreEditor packet are allowed to use on your websites only with providing their sources.

8. License holder isn't allowed for

- Hire, copy or any other sharing and disseminate form of registered CoreEditor packet;
- Deassembling, decompiling of CoreEditor packet code;
- Disseminate and sharing scripts, templates, menus and another packet files and also any intervention into this code;
- Sharing bought registry codes for program;

9. Reliability of harms limitations

Licensor isn't responsible for any harm which would be as a result of usage CoreEditor packet, and also doesn't give any guarantee in physical defects matter. User has a duty to learn DEMO version before purchase of packet. The use is liability for suitable choice and results of usage packet. Licensor liability regards to software functionality conformity with the user manual. In this case the legal user of CoreEditor packet is provided with limited guarantee valid by 60 days time since CoreEditor purchasing.

The Licensor isn't liable for any harms resulted as misusing and not corrected work any scripts and additions installed with packet together.

Additionally the Licensor isn't responsible for harms (also lost money) of license holder related with use and impossibility of packet usage.

10. The place of settling possible matters
